**Statement about the Bylaws Amendment**

This proposed Bylaw amendment is based on input and recommendation from the Working Group on Volunteer Engagement, which is composed of two HOD members and three BOD members. The new name, Council on Public Health, is recommended to clarify that the Council's focus is public health. Regulatory medicine is currently handled by various committees and councils, including Animal Agriculture Liaison Committee, Committee on Environmental Issues, Council on Veterinary Service, Committee on Antimicrobials, and Animal Welfare Committee.

The name change is not intended, nor does it imply, any substantive changes to the Council's role or responsibilities.
